STAGE IN PARIS 2012

October-November 2012

The Paris Bar organises every year an International Stage in Paris and invites one lawyer from each jurisdiction to participate. The stage is a fantastic opportunity for lawyers to discover and practice French law in the heart of Paris.

The stage takes place during the months of October and November and entails: one month attending classes at the *l'Ecole de Formation du Barreau* and one month of work experience in a law firm in Paris. The programme also includes a visit to Brussels to know the European Institutions.

The Irish participant will be selected by the EU & International Affairs Committee of the Law Society of Ireland. Candidates must:

- ❑ **Be qualified in Ireland and registered in the Law Society.**
- ❑ **Be fluent in French.**
- ❑ **Be under 40 years old.**
- ❑ **Have insurance cover** (for accidents and damages).

Tuition is completely covered by the Paris Bar; candidates must be willing to cover other expenses (travel, accommodation, meals)¹
