

Increase in court fees with effect from 10th April 2012

Supreme Court:

- Filing an affidavit goes up from €13 to €19.

High Court

NB:

- Commercial Court: Filing of Notice of Motion for entry on the Commercial Court list has been set at **€5,000**. This replaces the multi-stage fee arrangement currently applied. The fee is refundable if application to the list is unsuccessful.
- Taxing Master: On a Summons to Tax, an increase from 6% to 8% will be applied.
- Judgment Mortgage: Application for endorsement of a cert of registration of a judgment mortgage in the PRA - a new fee of €17 will be applied.
- Probate Office: Lodgment or re-entry of any Motion Paper will increase from €17 to €40. Entry of a caveat will increase from €17 to €50.

Circuit Court:

- Judgment Mortgage: See above.
- Summons to Tax: See above.

District Court:

- Family: Second or subsequent copy order - a new fee of €15 will be applied.
- Judgment Mortgage: See above.
- Licensing Register: Inspection of Licensing or Clubs Register - fee will increase from €28 to €35.
- Dance Licence: Application will increase from €135 to €335.
