Important Information about the EPA Installer

1. The installer needs to be saved and run on a local machine (your PC). It should continue to install even if a message displays to say there is an issue. Accept any security warnings that your browser may give, as this file has been checked and is virus-free.

2. For installing on a network, you will need to run the installer on each machine that requires use of the application. Details are in the [reference manual](#).
 3. The installer will not overwrite a previous database.
 4. This software is no longer supported. It is over 5 years old and was written to work on Windows 2000 and Windows XP. There may be problems installing on Windows Vista and Windows 7.
 5. A number of small errors have been detected, notably:
 - with jointly/jointly and severally choices for substitute attorneys (sometimes the system forgets the settings)
 - with the address of the Wards of Court Office (which has changed in the meantime)
 - with Donor (or other) names longer than 40 characters
 6. All documents generated should be carefully proofread and annotated where necessary.

Tyrrell Associates is currently working on a web-based, updated version of the application and it is planned to release this some time in Autumn 2011.
