

FE-1 LAW OF TORTS EXAMINATION CANCELLED

Information Updated: 15 March 2020

The Law Society has been actively monitoring the advice being issued by the [Health Protection Surveillance Centre \(HPSC\)](#) and other Irish and International agencies and is following same. Given developments over the last 12 hours and the most recent advice from the HSE the Law Society has decided in the interests of public health and safety to cancel the sitting of the Law of Torts examination due to take place tomorrow ([Monday 16 March](#)). We know this will be a disappointment for many candidates but the Society must act in the health and safety interests of both our candidates and invigilators.

A refund will issue to all candidates registered to sit the Law of Torts examination in the coming weeks. We intend to convene new sittings of the European Union Law and Law of Torts papers at the earliest possible opportunity once the current health crisis has been resolved.
