Results

Your results will be posted to the address given on your application form approximately 6 – 8 weeks after the last examination. You must provide written notification of any change of address two weeks prior to results being issued.

Re-checking of Examination Scripts

A candidate may apply to the Society for a re-check of any examination script which he or she is deemed not to have passed, provided that the application for such a re-check is received in writing by the Society within fourteen days following the issue of the examination results, accompanied by a recheck fee of €115 per examination script.
