#### Results

Your results will be emailed to the address given on your application form approximately 6-8 weeks after the last examination.

#### **Re-checking of Examination Scripts**

A candidate may apply to the Society for a re-check of any examination script which he or she is deemed not to have passed, provided that the application for such a re-check is received in writing by the Society within fourteen days following the issue of the examination results, accompanied by a recheck fee of €140 per examination script.
