


- The Law Society Library provides information, reference and lending services to members of the Law Society and Law School trainees.








Library App – Search for a book

You can read the details of the book on screen and place a hold/reservation if you wish by tapping "Place Reservation".




The pickup location defaults to the Law Society of Ireland.
