



## Director of Finance and Operations

- Overseeing the estate management, which includes facilities, commercial services, sustainability, and coordinating major site development projects.
- Ensuring that IT resources are aligned to support the Society's strategic objectives.

As a member of the Senior Management Team, the new appointee will play an important role in the development and delivery of the Society's strategic objectives.

The ideal candidate will be a senior finance professional, highly experienced in developing and implementing financial and operational strategies. The new Director will bring a blend of strong communication, people and leadership skills.
